

Kentucky State Bowfishing Records Program

United Bowhunters of Kentucky Rules

This is a program whereby the UBK keeps records of who holds the distinction of having taken fish species by the means of a legal bow and fish arrow. The following rules must be met to apply.

Rules are as follows:

- 1 Opened to all licensed anglers bowfishing Kentucky waters only.
- 2 All records will be kept on file by UBK and available for inspection.
- 3 The entrant must furnish the UBK with a picture of the fish next to a measurable object (preferably yourself, use a good camera and take a well lighted close-up), and a signed affidavit by two witnesses stating that they were present at the time of said weighing.
- 4 All entrants to be considered for a **KSBRP state record** must be weighed on a certified scale (one legal for trade) to the nearest ounce. At least two witnesses present during weighing and measuring. (Scales maybe found at feed mills, some marinas, meat markets, local butcher shops, etc.) **The fish species identification must be verified in person by a Kentucky Department of Fish & Wildlife fisheries biologist or KSBRP official to be considered for a state record after fish is weighed.**
- 5 State records will be listed in Kentucky Bowhunter magazine and by the Kentucky Department of Fish & Wildlife (KDFWR)
- 6 To qualify, all fish must have been taken on or after June 1 of 2002.
